The **seach predictions** are determined by:

- the actual search term
- your search history if a Google account is used
- what others search (see Google Trends)

Excluded are terms that violate the **autocomplete policies**, such as violence or sexually eplicit terms

How is the position of a result determined?

- · how many sites link to a site
- · how relevant the linking sites are
- your current location
- your language
- · the device you are using
- how fast the website loads
- how user-friendly the site is
- useful and updated content
- paying \$ to Google let's you place an ad
- a high position can't be bought
