The **search predictions** are determined by:

- the actual search term
- your **search history** if a Google account is used
- what others search (see Google Trends)

Excluded are terms that violate the **autocomplete policies**, such as violence or sexually explicit terms

How is the position of a result determined?

- how many sites link to a site
- how relevant the linking sites are
- your current location
- your language
- the device you are using
- how fast the website loads
- how user-friendly the site is
- useful and updated content
- paying \$ to Google let's you place an ad
- a high position **can't be bought**

Google Search I'm Feeling Lucky

Hovering over this button with an empty search bar will let it randomly change to something like - **I'm Feeling Hungry** Searching might then result in some dinner recipes.

If a term can be found in the search bar, *I'm Feeling Lucky* will skip the results page and directly forward you to the first result

You can exclude with a dash
beatle -var

File types

Search for certain files
bible filetype:pdf

Grouping

Use paranthesis to group
(fast OR slow) car

Hashtags

Search for a hashtag
#photooftheday

In text

Search in text
intext:blog
allintext:blog cooking

In title

Search for htm title tags
intitle:blog
allintitle:blog cooking

In URL

Search for URLs
inurl:blog
allinurl:blog cooking

Results are related to either one or all of the operands
computer OR mouse
computer | mouse

Find sites which are related
related:google.com
Result: bing, yahoo, etc.

Search a site only

only search on a specific site
site:youtube.com pewdiepie

Wildcard

Use * as a placeholder
the best * in the world
